WHAT WILL WE BE DOING?

The YAB will give you the chance to be at the heart of decision making for young people in GamCare.

Your voice, ideas and opinions are key to what we achieve together!

In 2021/2022, the Board will work across different projects

- **You will get the chance to observe our team at work, offer ideas to make it better, co-create content and even co-deliver some training - if you like!**
- **You will get the opportunity to develop posts, videos and all types of content for our social media pages!**
- **You will be making decisions and help organise awareness campaigns, residentials and meet-ups across the UK.**
- **If you have lived experience of being affected by gambling, you can give us a clearer insight on how we can support people better.**
- **And you will be helping us reach everyone with our programme and services from every community, belief and background.**





HOW WILL WE WORK?

- **The YAB will last up to 12 months.**
- **We will be attending monthly online meetings.**
- **These meetings will take place mainly in the evenings, can be arranged to suit everyone's needs.**
- **If it is possible to have face-to-face meetings these will take place across the UK with the aim to have at least one meeting in London.**
- **At the meetings Youth Advisors will hold discussions, present ideas, give opinions, co-create content and more.**
- **There will be chances to participate in workshops and training for specific projects as well as help with staff recruitment.**

WHO CAN JOIN?

- Any young person aged 11-17 interested can join.
- We welcome young people from all communities, backgrounds and beliefs, especially those that feel unheard within society.
- Whether you gamble yourself, experiencing gambling related harm, affected by someone else's gambling or have never gambled at all, you are invited to take part.
